## Reading questions for Anttila 1997

Bring your answer to class to turn in on Friday, Sept. 7.

Anttila uses a particular set of constraints to model his data. In order to prepare for our discussion of his model and how it might work with different sets of constraints, propose a set of constraints that is basically similar but either

- collapses some of the constraints together (so that you have fewer constraints) or
- splits some of the constraints (so that they make finer distinctions)

When you use Anttila's constraints or system of naming constraints, you don't need to give a definition, but if you propose something new be sure to give at least an informal definition.
